



Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to inform you about a few dates for your diary. As you may be aware your child will be receiving all of their mock examination results in a formal manner on Monday 8th January. As we are now on the final countdown to their GCSE examinations in the summer, with only 12 more school Mondays to go before the external examinations begin, it is vital that we work together to try to assist your child in achieving the best results they can.
