Your son/daughter is currently studying the AQA GCSE Physical Education course. As part of this course they are required to complete a Rock Climbing Assessment that will take place at Boulder Central in West Bromwich. Pupils have been here before but this time will be participating in their final assessment which will be filmed by GSA Staff.

This assessment will take place in your son/daughter's normal GCSE PE lesson on a Monday afternoon for 3 weeks. Pupils will leave the Academy at the start of lunch (12:45pm) on Monday 26th February, Monday 5th March and Monday 12th March and will return back to school by 3pm ready for intervention.
